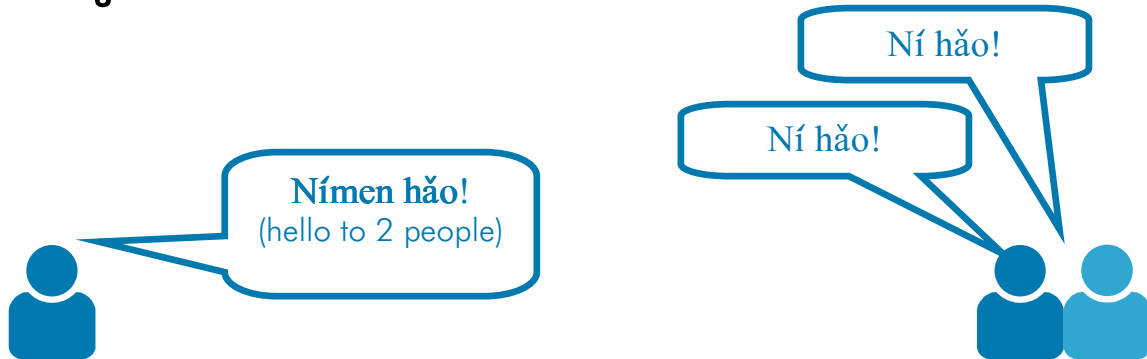


Pronouns are words used to refer to a person or thing, instead of saying the actual name of the person or thing. Examples in English are I, you, he, she, it, they, we, my, your, his, her, their, our, me, him, her, them, us.... and the list goes on! You will find that the Chinese system of pronouns is quite logical.

### Extension

wǒ = I  
nǐ = you  
tā = he/she

wǒmen = we  
nǐmen = you (plural)  
tāmen = they

Tā jiào shénme? = What's his/her name?  
Tā jiào Frank = His name is Frank

Nimen shì nǎ guó rén? = Which country are you (both) from?  
Wǒmen shì jiā ná dà rén = We are from Canada

Tāmen shì nǎ guó rén? = Which country are they from?  
Tāmen shì ào dà lì yà rén = They are Australian
